GED Option 2

Daniela Stuckey and Scott Bostwick reviewed a proposal to offer the GED Option #2 for eligible students who would attend the Alternative Learning Center. These students are those who are currently served by the High School Equivalency Diploma program. The GED Option #2 (GEDO #2) Program allows authorized school districts to use the GED test battery to measure proficiency in lieu of high school credit for students enrolled in an alternative education program. A student who passes the GED tests and completes the other requirements for graduation is entitled to the traditional high school diploma. The committee authorized the high school administration to continue planning for the GED0 #2 in time for the 2010-11 school year.

WHS Program of Studies

Dave Vitale presented documentation of three course proposals for the 2010-11 school year. Courses in Physical Education, Music, and Special Education programming were discussed as to whether they will be included in the registration booklet that is distributed to students in February 2010. New courses that appear in the registration booklet are subject to enrollment minimums determined by the administration before they commence.
