Other Information to Note.....

√ **Test security**

- All staff who work with assessments, communicate test results to others and/or receives testing information are responsible for test security.

√ **Calculator Use**

- No calculators will be permitted during any session for grades 3 and 4. Only students whose IEP or Section 504 plan allows the accommodation of calculator usage may use a calculator for non-computation sessions of the mathematics test.
- A calculator is required for grades 5, 6, 7, 8, and 10. In grades 5-8, all students must have either a four-function, scientific or graphing calculator during calculator-required sessions.
- In grade 10, all students must have either a scientific or graphing calculator (graphing calculators offer no advantage during the testing).

√ **Grades 3, 5, 6, and 7 will have 1 book with 4 forms**

√ **Grades 4 and 8 will have 2 books**

- Book 1 has Reading, Math and Science
- Book 2 has Language Arts, Writing and Social Studies

√ **Grade 10 has 2 books**

- Book 1 includes Reading, Math and Science
- Book 2 includes Language Arts, Writing and Social Studies

√ **Writing Prompts include the following:**

- Grade 4, Descriptive
- Grades 8 and 10, Persuasive

√ **New This Year**

- Wisconsin Alternate Assessment will be done January 7-31, 2008
